RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are teaching the God strand in classes. The Catholic teaching of God which has been handed down in the Scriptures and the Tradition has the Trinity at its centre. The same Scriptures and Tradition also contain other images of God which help our understanding of who God is. Throughout our lives we develop our own images of God.

Some suggestions to use at home:

- Spend a few quiet minutes with each child thinking about who God is and sharing your image of God
- Read a Psalm each night and think about the image of God it shows
- Take time to admire something God has created and give thanks and praise for it
