### ART EXPO

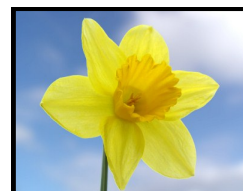
Thank you for your donations collected over the last two weeks from the Art Expo. We raised **\$178.30** to go to the Missions. Your generosity is much appreciated.
