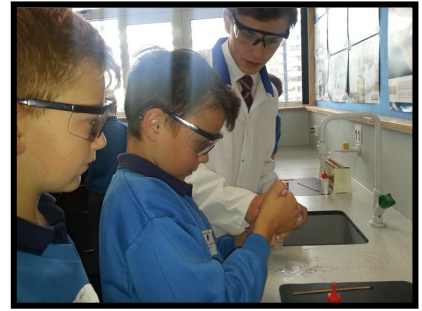

TERM 2, 2015

Hall Update

We have recently received the disappointing news from the Palmerston North Diocese that the start date for the building of our new hall has been delayed. Whilst they are still committed to the hall design and original funding agreement we have been advised they will be looking at beginning the project after a budget review in May 2016. The delay is largely due to three large structural strengthening jobs in secondary schools in the diocese region being given top priority due to safety issues identified through recent structural assessments (potential for collapse of two-storey buildings included). The extent of work required for these prioritised jobs has surprised the Diocese and was unforeseen, and they had to make a decision to prioritise Health & Safety.

Obviously we were very disappointed to receive this news however we can understand why priority must go to remedying the highest risks our fellow schools have. Importantly, we know we will get a new hall eventually, as our existing hall must be strengthened or replaced.

The Government has recently advised that the policy guidelines for use of buildings assessed as having the risks that our existing hall does, has changed and owners of buildings in this situation now have up to 15 years to remedy their buildings either by strengthening or replacing. This is a change to Government policy and is not the Board's interpretation. This means that we can continue to occupy our existing hall until the new hall is completed. Nonetheless the board will seek independent advice on this matter and will of course continue to monitor any changes in the situation and update you accordingly.

Whilst we are committed to ensuring the school eventually receives a new hall, the board is equally committed to making sure that in waiting for the new hall, other school improvement opportunities are not missed. If you have any questions about this situation, or opportunities you would like us to consider, please get in touch.
