HEALTH AND PE CONSULTATION

MEMO FROM NAPIER CITY COUNCIL

The Council will be laying new stormwater drains and sewer pipelines in Guppy Road from 28th October (today) and will be closed to all north bound traffic for up to 4 weeks. During this period northbound heavy vehicles will be diverted along Osier Rd to Gloucester Street and other vehicles to McKeefry Avenue.
