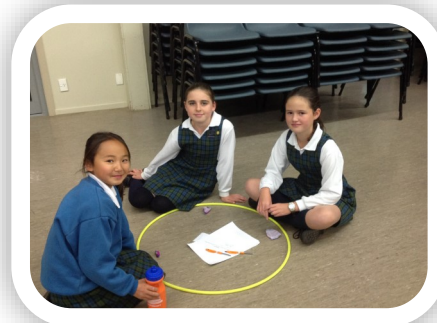

## **A Vision and Mission for the Catholic Parish of Napier – Consultation**



### **What this is about**

All parishioners are invited to have their say on a proposed vision and mission for the parish.

The proposal was developed with input from the members of all parish leadership teams. It was further refined by the Strategic Planning Group, which consists of the Chairpersons of the Parish Pastoral Council, the Finance Committee, and the Liturgy Committee, one of the Parish Priests, and one of the Catholic School Principals.

### **What is a vision and what is a mission?**

A vision statement is an inspiring and aspirational description of what we want to be as a parish.

A mission statement explains why we exist, what our purpose is as a parish.

### **Why do we need a vision and a mission?**

A vision and mission give us focus as a parish. When we share a vision and mission, it helps us work together to become the people God created us to be. A vision and a mission will also be our guide in development of a strategic plan for the parish.

### **How you can participate in this consultation**

If you wish to participate in the consultation, please print the second page of this document and answer the questions. Your submission is anonymous, so please do not put your name on the paper.

You can submit in the following ways:

- By putting your answers in the submission box in one of our three churches, at Reignier School or at St Patrick's School;
- By putting your answers in the letter box at the Parish Office, 58 Osier Road, Greenmeadows;
- By posting your answers to the Parish Pastoral Council Chairperson, 58 Osier Road, Greenmeadows, Napier 4112.

The final date for submission is Sunday 5 June 2016.

### **What happens next**

The Strategic Planning Group will consider all responses and make amendments to the proposed vision and mission. The amended vision and mission will be sent for ratification to a combined meeting of all leadership teams and Catholic Primary/Intermediate School principals in August.

The Strategic Planning Group is also starting the development of a Strategic Plan for the parish, which is planned to be completed by the end of 2016. Your views on a proposed plan will be asked later in the year.
