YEAR 5/6 KIWI SOCCER AFTERNOON

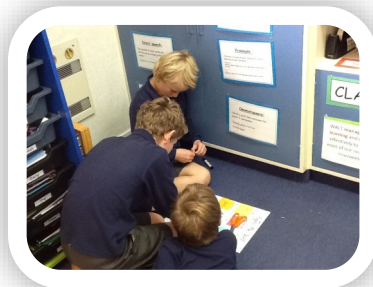
