Welcome back to term 2 everybody. We hope you had a lovely Easter and a relaxing holiday break.

We warmly welcome our new students Aiyavee Sadakorn and Macy Humphrey (Room 5) to our school community, and we especially welcome Ms Amy Lee our new Deputy Principal and teacher in Room 10. It's great to finally have Amy as a part of our school community and Reignier staff team.

The hall project is moving along quickly and is still on schedule to be completed by the July holidays. 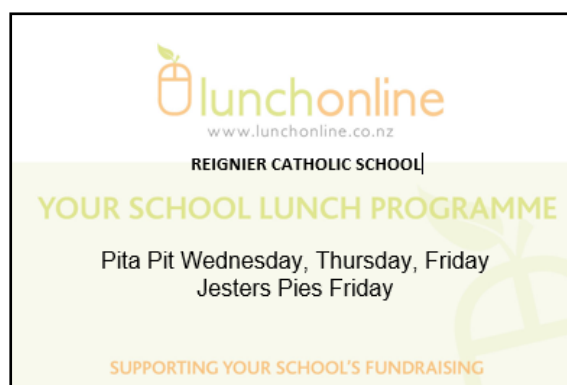
2017 Attendance Dues Reminder
