### POSITIVE NORM

#### Setting Up Positive Norms in Maths Class

Every 3 weeks the whole school will be focussing on one positive message that encourages Maths in the classroom

Mistakes are valuable.

Mistakes grow your brain! It is good to struggle and make mistakes.

Mistakes offer opportunities for great learning to take place.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We have begun teaching the God strand in our classrooms. Here are some suggestions to use at home to support this.

- ✓ Spend a few quiet minutes with each child thinking about who God is and sharing your image of God-Te Atua- Lo Matua Kore
- ✓ Read a psalm each night and think about the image of God it shows
- ✓ Take time to admire something God has created and give thanks and praise for it
- ✓ Buy a new Bible if you need to and spend time reading it

This focus for each class is (with the Family/Whanau reference in brackets) Nest 5: God is Creator (page 17), Nests 2, 3 and 4: Our Gracious God (page 20), Rooms 6, 7 and 8: God is Love (page 26), Rooms 9 and 10: God is Faithful (page 29)
