Greetings Everyone

We warmly welcome Lukas Heron (Room 8) and his family to Reignier.

We are starting to come to the business end of the second term. I want to thank the teachers for the extra hours they have put in to make sure that the reports are ready to go home next week Friday, 22nd June. This will be followed by the Parent Interview afternoon/evenings which will take place on Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th June respectively. Our school code is cdqr9**. If you do not have access to a computer, please see your child's classroom teacher or connect with the office to help you with this. Please remember, we encourage your child to be part of this conversation. Bring them along to the interview so they can be empowered to take responsibility for their own learning. A flyer with all relevant information will go home next week to serve as a reminder of school hours during this time. **Please make sure that you are aware of the days that we are closing earlier due to the Parent Interviews and also the upcoming paid union meeting on the 28th of June.**

Ms Davis and I are away from school from tomorrow until Friday to attend the Catholic Education Convention in Wellington that takes place every three years. It is an expectation from the Bishop that all Directors of Religious Education and Principals should attend. In my absence Mrs Riceman and Miss Lee will be acting on my behalf. I want to thank them knowing that our school is in good hands.

Over the last few weeks, I have been having conversations with our tamariki about certain expectations we, the teachers, have for them here at school. I do not want them to use any "wheels" in the quad area of the school due to the health and safety reasons. I have also spoken about expectations in wearing the correct school uniform to and from school. I also emphasised that the girls should have long hair tied back and be wearing the correct jewellery eg studs only in ears. Boys were asked when they are wearing a thermal under their uniform to make sure it is tucked in. Remember this is what is setting us apart from our neighbouring schools. I also want to emphasise that after school activity on the playground equipment must be supervised by a parent or an adult, this is again because of health and safety rules and regulations.

Today our year 6 boys are all going to St John's College in Hastings for a taster day, I know that they will find this an enriching experience. Mrs Gibson will be going with them and I thank her for giving her time to look after our boys. We also have the Strike Percussion group here at school today and our future 'musicians' will find this very enjoyable. I thank Mrs Mellon for her arrangements in making this possible.

Thursday 14th June is the Taradale Cluster football day when a very large number of our children will be participating at Park Island. I want to thank Mr Nairn, Mrs Gibson, Mrs Smith and Mrs Harvey who will be going with the children. I know that our children will do us proud. On Friday 15th June our Rippa Rugby stars will be participating in the annual inter-schools competition at Tareha Park. I thank Mr Nairn their coach and Mrs Harvey who are going with them.
