NETBALL SKIRTS

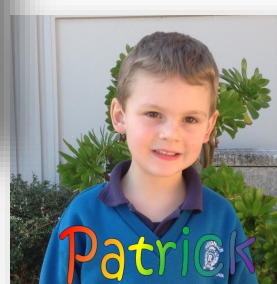
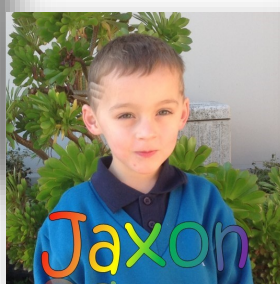
